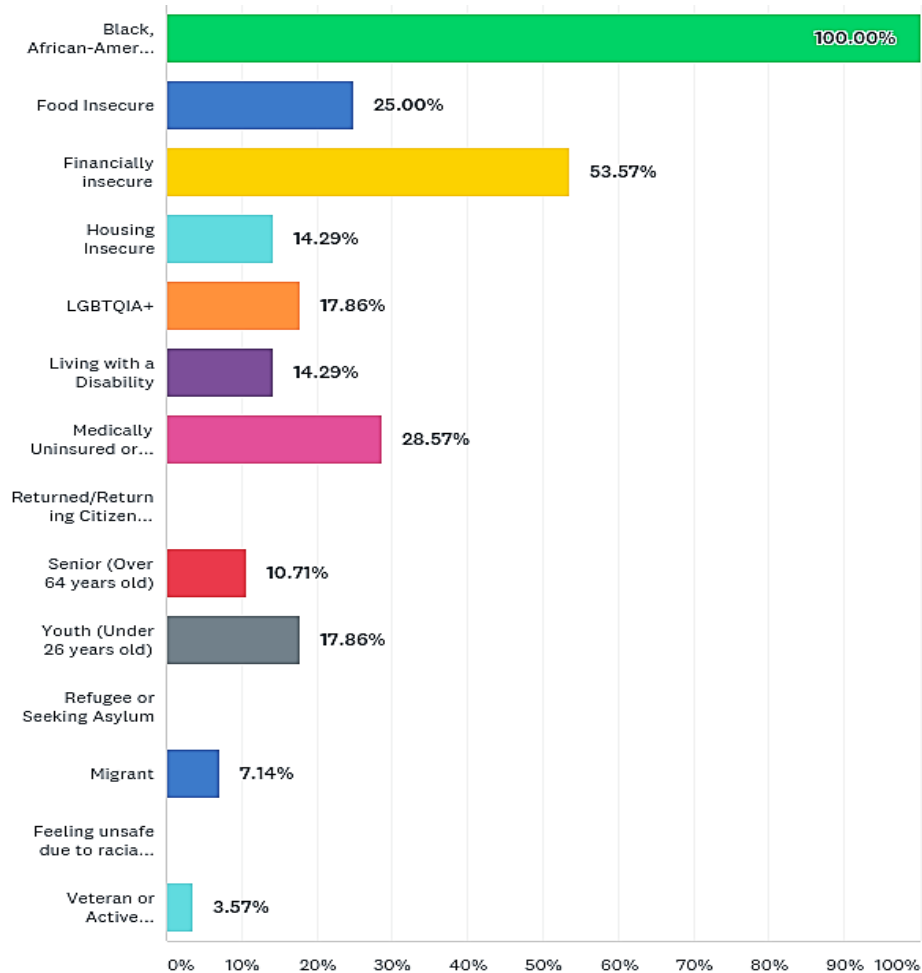

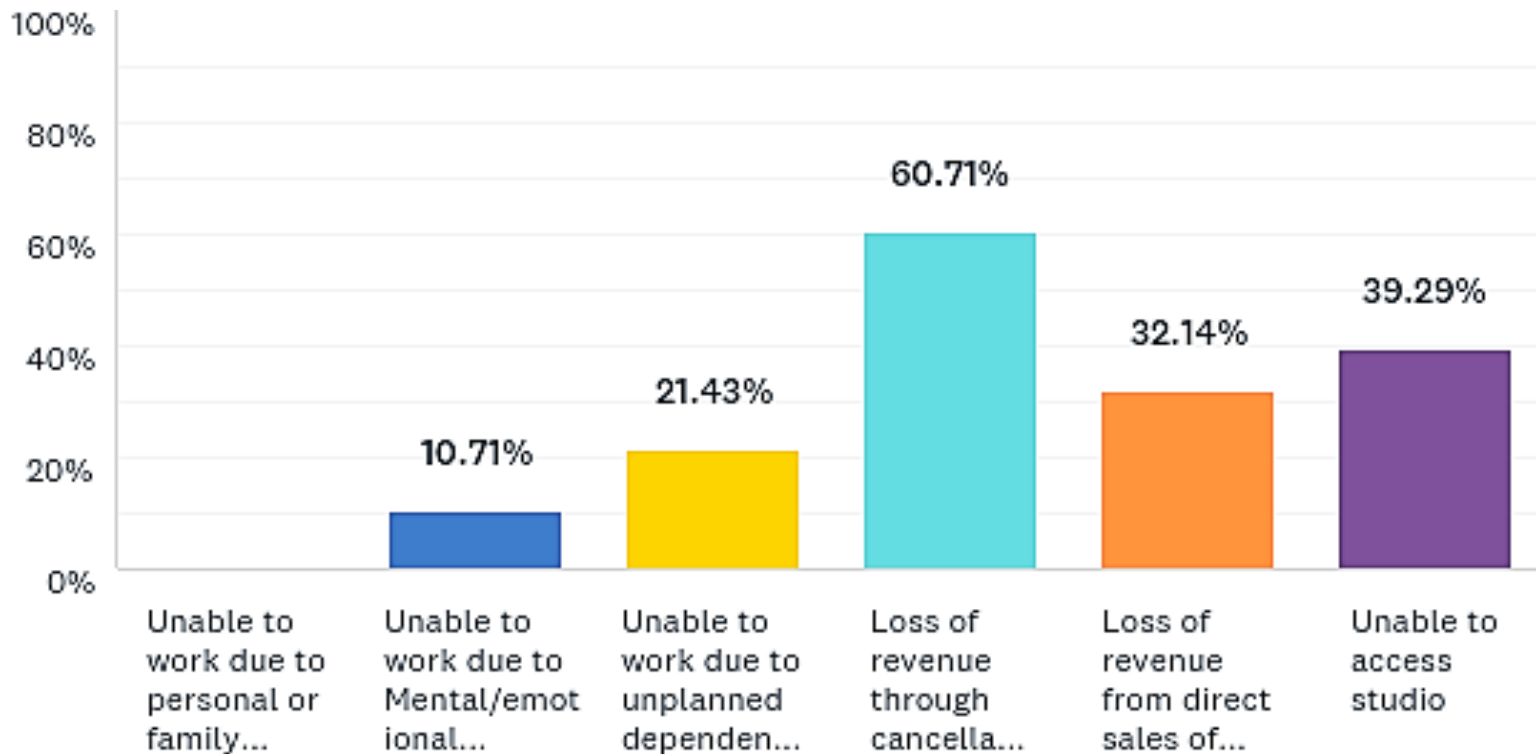

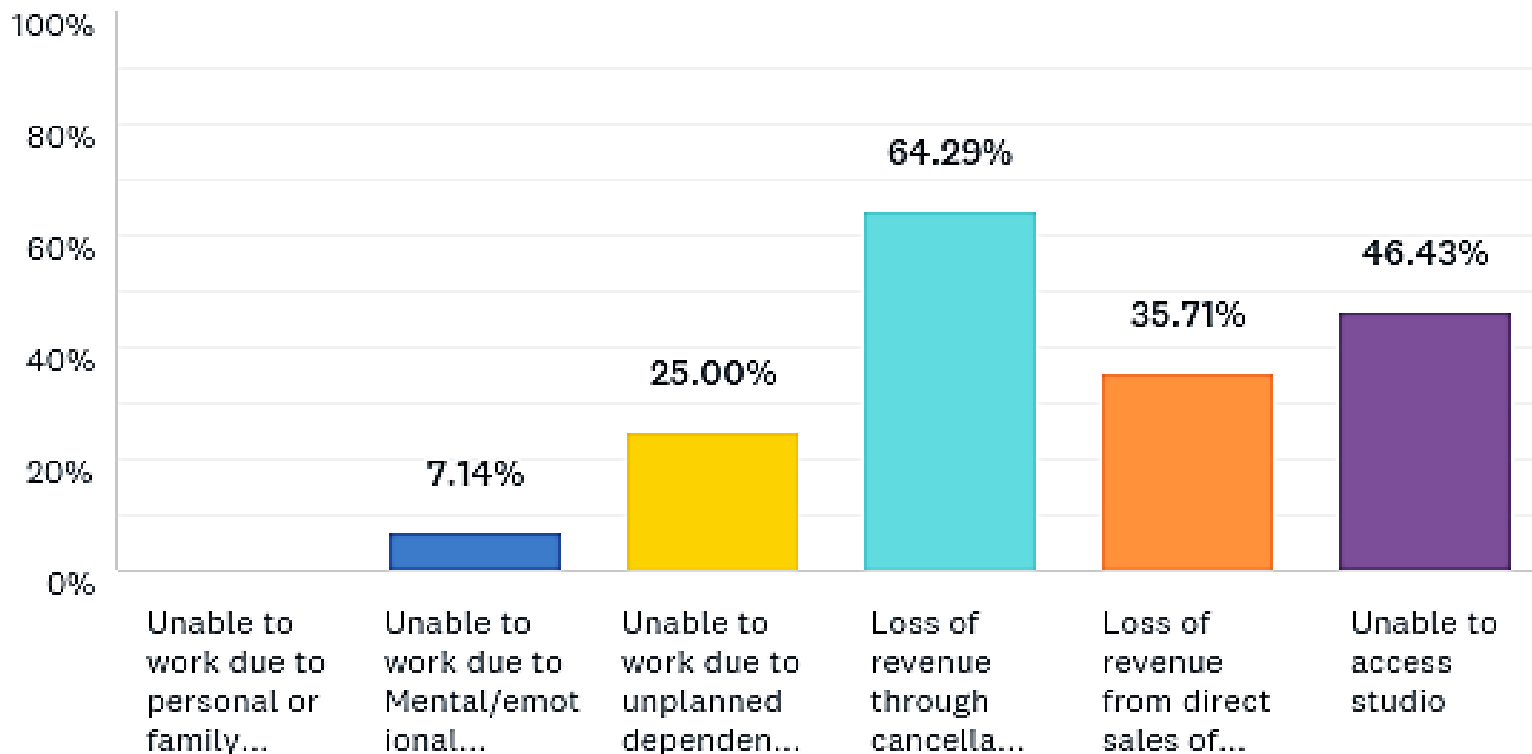
Q2: How are you being impacted by COVID-19 right now? (Check all that apply)

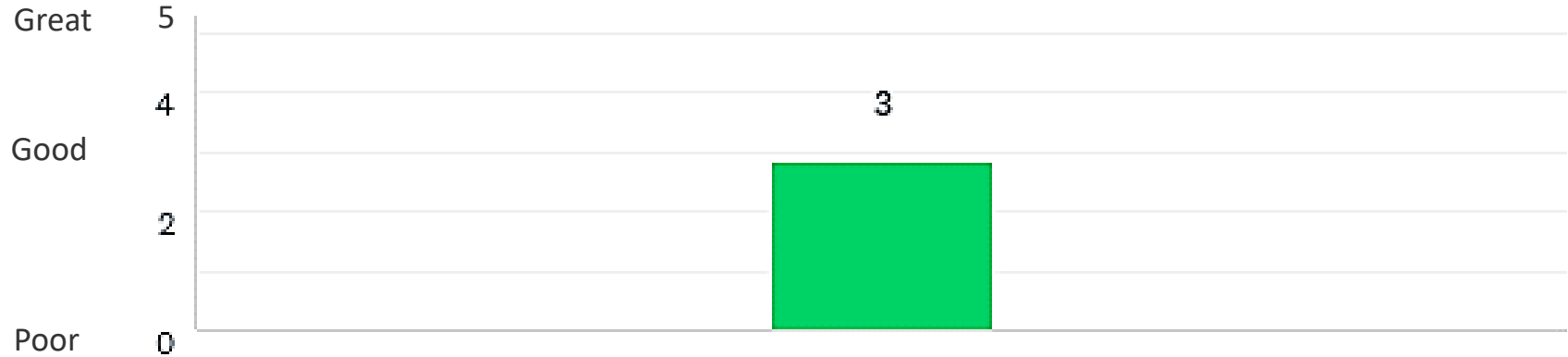

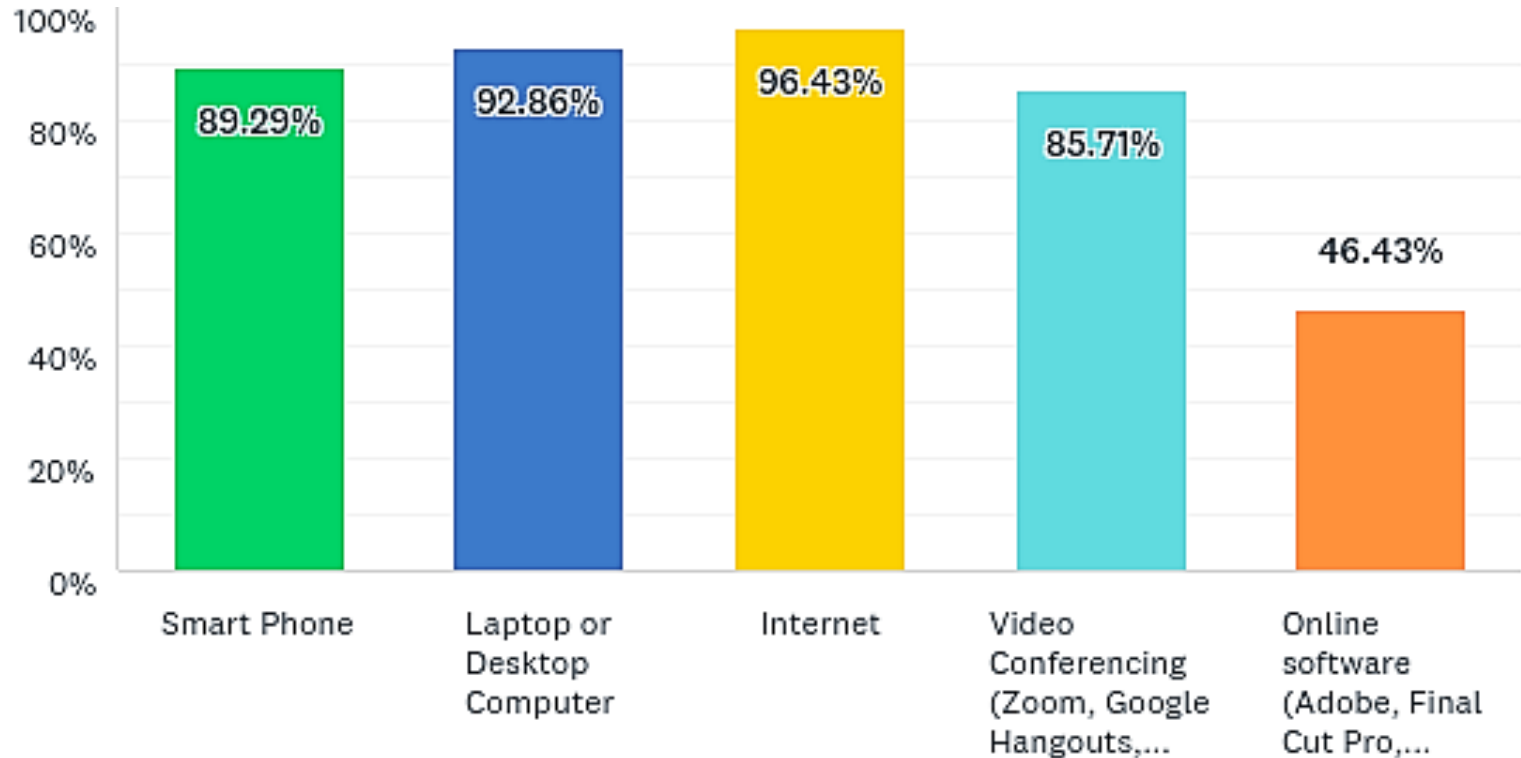

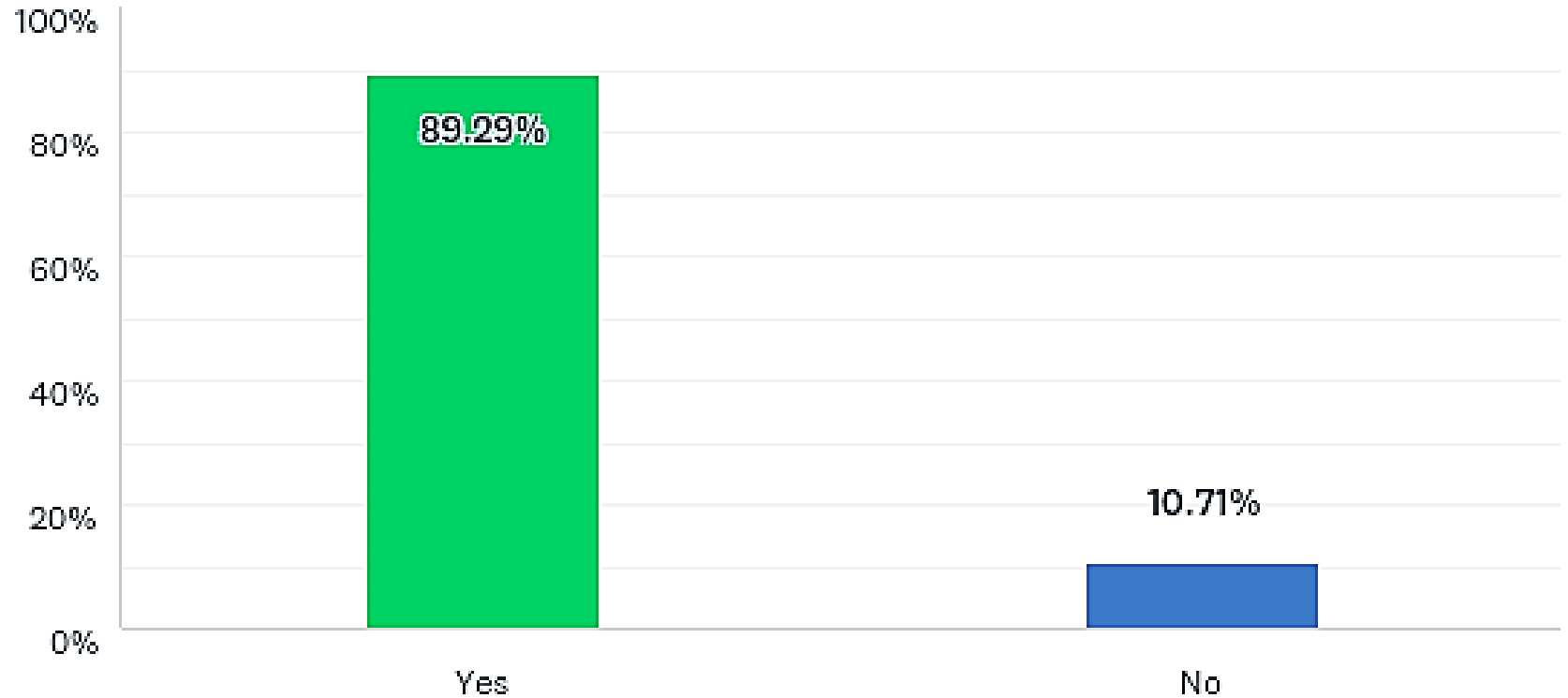

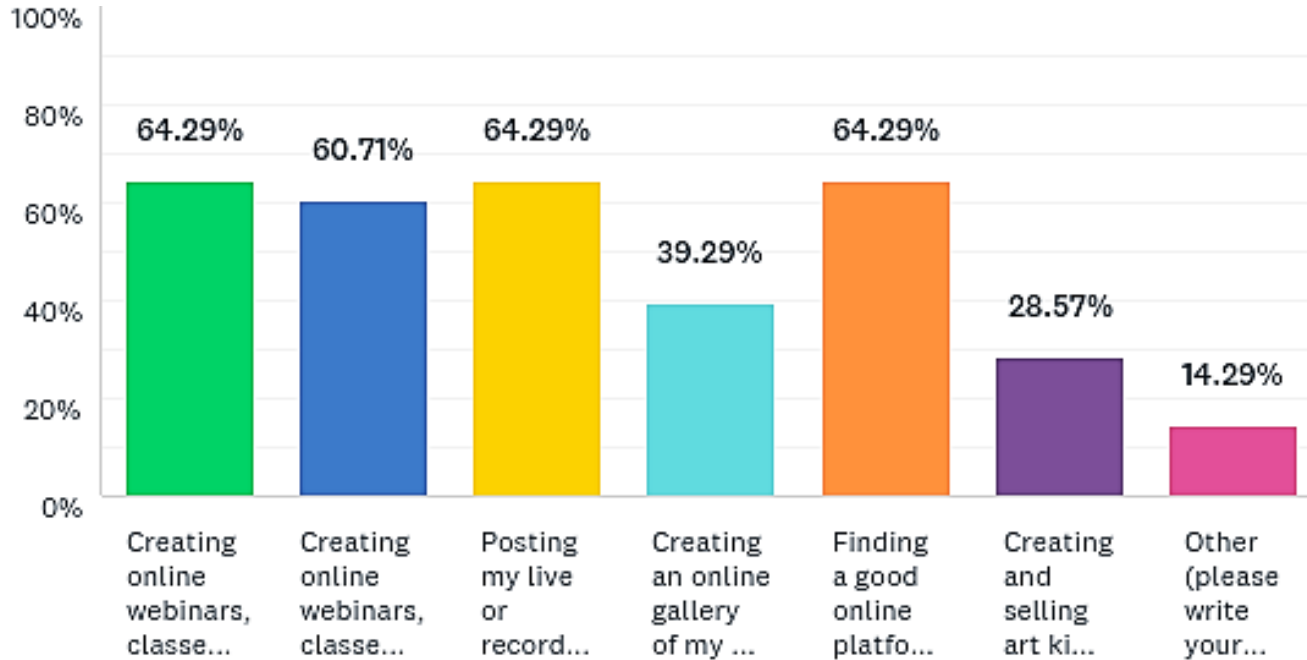
